

Campus Visit Checklist

While on your campus visit, talk to as many people as you can and get a feel for the atmosphere. Don't pass up a chance to ask questions. Use this campus visit checklist to assist you during your campus tours.

- Visit the school's website to learn how to set up a campus tour. Tours are usually held throughout the day so you may need to plan your day around this.
- Schedule interviews with campus officials in admission, academic advising, housing and in your field of study.
- Don't forget campus maps and your list of questions for each campus office.
- Grab any financial aid or application forms you may need.
- If possible, sit in on a class that interests you. Talk to coaches or sponsors of activities you're interested in.
- Scan bulletin boards to see what activities are available. This is also a good way to get a feel for jobs available in the area.
- Eat in the cafeteria or around campus to check out the food available to you.
- Visit the dormitory if you plan to live on campus. Ask about rules concerning what you can and can't bring with you.
- Talk with students about the campus and ask questions. Pick up a school newspaper to get an idea of the campus culture.
- Visit the college bookstore to price new and used books.
