- » A packet of information for middle school counselors containing college planning resources and ideas to help keep their students engaged and thinking about education after high school.

OCAP and OSRHE Publications

- » *Are You Looking for Money?* – a booklet that highlights financial aid, which includes grants, scholarships and student loans.
- » *Are You Ready for College?* – a booklet that provides students considering college insight on income potential, career choice and choosing a college.
- » *Your Money Matters* – a guide highlighting budgeting, saving, college planning, student loan management, banking and consumer credit developed by Oklahoma Money Matters for high school and college students.
- » *Oklahoma's Promise* flyer – explains the criteria for Oklahoma's Promise, a scholarship program for Oklahoma students.
- » *Do You Have a Plan for College* booklet – contains important college planning information, including salary comparisons, courses to take, college requirements and types of schools. **(Counselors receive a bulk supply of this publication in August each year.)**
- » *The Counselors' Resource Book to Oklahoma's Colleges and Universities* – formerly known as *The Official Guide to Oklahoma's Colleges and Universities*, this publication contains an overview of higher education institutions as well as information about getting into college and paying for higher education.
