*Are You Looking for Money?* and *Are You Ready for College?* are comprehensive, user-friendly guides to the financial aid and college planning processes. These publications offer information on federal and state financial aid, scholarships, completing the FAFSA and choosing the right college. Our high school checklists have now been included in the *Are You Ready for College?* publication.

*Your Money Matters*, an Oklahoma Money Matters (OKMM) publication, is a personal finance guide highlighting budgeting, saving, student loan management, banking and consumer credit. Versions for high school and college students (pictured) are available, as well as low-resourced adults and adults in the workplace.



*Do You Have a Plan for College?* is a publication of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education. With one version for juniors and seniors and another for 8th-10th graders, these publications are packed with important information about taking the right classes, researching colleges and paying for college.

The *Oklahoma's Promise Flyer* explains the benefits and eligibility requirements of the Oklahoma's Promise scholarship program, which allows Oklahoma students to earn free college tuition if they meet certain academic and conduct requirements in high school. To qualify, family income can't exceed \$50,000 at the time of application, and additional income restrictions apply when the student begins college. Students must enroll in 8th, 9th or 10th grade (home school students must enroll at age 13, 14 or 15).
