



Let's Go to College: School Spirit (4th & 5th Grade)

Make Your Own Spirit Stick



Dorm Room Decoration

Regional University – A college that has a mid-size student body, focuses on teaching and public service and offers a variety of courses. Classrooms at these colleges usually hold 30 – 50 students.

Research University – A college that has a large student body, offers a wide variety of courses and focuses on doing research projects. Classrooms at these colleges usually hold 50 – 200 students.
